

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D. O. Letter No. 182/3PNDT/15

Dear Sh Meena,

Please refer to D.O. No. V25011/444/2011-HR (Vol-II)(Part), dated October 26, 2015, pertaining to draft legislation, namely, "The Assisted Reproductive Technology (Regulation) Bill, 2014".

The draft legislation was examined in depth and while, section wise detailed comments(attached) have been made, the broader suggestions on the structure of statutory bodies and regulatory aspects, to ensure effective regulation of the ART Clinics are provided below.

1/ It is worth noting that ART Clinics are presently registered as Genetic Clinics or Genetic Laboratories under the PC & PNDT Act. Hence, the proposed legislation should have an organic linkage with the PC & PNDT Act.

2/ It is felt that full time statutory bodies may not be required for regulation of the ART Clinics and Banks. Instead, a leaner structure at National and State level is proposed for the purpose of regulation. It is further felt that we may rather utilise the regulatory structure, already created, under PC & PNDT Act.

3/ The regulation making powers may be exercised as per the PC & PNDT Act.

4/ To ensure effective regulation, the powers of monitoring could be solely vested in the State Board.

5/ Most importantly, dual registration should be avoided. Instead, registration should be the mandate of the registration authorities at State/Divisional/District Level. An online system at the national level could be put in place to ensure seamless flow of information to regulatory bodies.

The proposed legislation, while covering an important area, needs to be framed in a manner that it ensures effective regulation but does not add a verticality to the current regulatory structures already in place in the health sector. It is also felt that there are certain sections, which have dwelt in detail on the technical aspects, whereas, it could be considered that the proposed Act defines the broad philosophy and principles but leaves the details to regulations, which can evolve from time to time.
